Campa	aign Finance Reform
	Pennsylvania is one of 11 states with no campaign contribution limit for state races
	PA state lawmakers are the third highest paid in U.S., but accomplish less actual lawmaking
	PA is one of two states that doesn't explicitly ban or limit candidates from spending campaign funds on personal expenses
Comm	unity Health and Gun Violence Prevention
	Pennsylvania has the 8th highest rate of opioid deaths out of the 50 states
	Black Pennsylvanians are 25 times more likely to be killed in a gun homicide
	In PA, Black women are 3 times more likely to die during or after pregnancy than white women
Crimin	al Justice Reform
	Pennsylvania's proposed risk-assessment tool, giving judges the necessary information to divert low-risk individuals from prison to alternative sentencing programs is racist
Econo	mic Equality
	PA is one of 20 states still using the Federal minimum wage of \$7.25 per hour (nearby states of MD, DE, NJ, NY and OH all pay higher wages)
	PA is the 6th worst state in which to start a new business
	PA is 24th in the nation for worker-friendly policies
	Poverty rate is 60% higher within three miles of power plants compared to rest of the state
Educat	tion
	PA school funding is most unequal (rich vs. poor districts) in the nation due to over-emphasis on local funding
	PA residents graduate from college with the third highest amount of debt in the country
	Pennsylvania ranks 30 th in the US in quality of public education for all
	Pre-K program spending is well below PA's border states who spend four times what we do
	PA has worst community college system considering in-state tuition and graduation rates
Equity	and LGBTQ+ Rights
	Pennsylvania ranks 24 out of 50 in legal protections for LGBTQ+ people and has no statewide law prohibiting discrimination against LGBTQ people, meaning it is legal to fire someone, evict them from housing, or deny them service at a restaurant just because they are LGBTQ+
	PA ranks 40 of 50 states in the share of women in elected office; this is up in 2019 from 49
	PA is ground zero for hate, with residents reporting the most incidents of mail, fliers, stickers, posters, banners, graffiti and other messages encouraging hate. Virginia was 2nd and Texas, 3rd

Environmental Protection and Intrastructure	
	Pennsylvania ranks 44 in the state of our natural environment
	Pennsylvania is the only state that does not tax those pulling oil and gas from our state
	Pennsylvania has the third worst drinking water in the country; One-third (27,886 miles of streams statewide) of all PA waterways are polluted enough to harm wildlife, recreation or drinking water
	PA got a C- from the American Society of Civil Engineers for aging/deteriorating water & sewage systems
	Pennsylvania is ranked #2 for having the most structurally deficient bridges in the US
	PA's roads are the 5th worst in the nation
	PA Power Sector was labeled 5th dirtiest in the nation
	Pennsylvania could be the 2nd-most flooded state in 2022 behind Florida
	People of color are 39% of the population living within three miles of existing & proposed power plants; yet they are only 22% of PA's total population
Livability	
	Pennsylvania ranked 41 out of 50 in an annual ranking of most livable states that looks at
	health care, education, economy, infrastructure, opportunity, fiscal stability, crime &
	corrections, and natural environment; this is down from 38 last year; related to infrastructure and economy, PA is 29 out of 50 in broadband access
Reproductive Rights and Access	
	82% of Pennsylvania counties have no abortion providers or Medicaid does not cover abortion. Public funding is available for abortion only in cases of life endangerment, rape or incest
